HOW TO....

Register a greyhound as a breeding female

- 1. Apply for a DNA testing kit through Greyhounds Australasia: www.galtd.org.au.
- 2. Download the 'Application to Register a Greyhound as a Breeding Female' from the GWIC website: www.gwic.nsw.gov.au.
- 3. Take your application form to the vet so they can perform a health and fitness check and attach a current C5 vaccination certificate.
- 4. Send the completed application to: registration@gwic.nsw.gov.au.
- 5. A pink greyhound identification card will be sent to the breeder, and breeding can commence.





Retirement notifications must be submitted to GWIC within 14 days of retiring your greyhound.

Even if you retire your greyhound through GAP.
