A participant must not keep any animal at a property where greyhounds are kept, trialled, trained or raced without being approved by the Commission. If you bring a new animal to your property, you must complete this form.

Section 41(2) of the Greyhound Racing Act 2017 requires a participant to make an application for an animal exemption order.

Details of domestic animals kept on premises

The Greyhound Racing Act 2017 does not allow a participant to keep any animal that is reasonably capable of being used as a lure of a property where greyhounds are kept, unless the Commission grants an exemption. This means that you must apply for an exemption if you keep other animals as well as greyhounds. To apply for an exemption, please tell us:

- What kind of animals do you keep on your property?
- How many of each animal do you have?
- How are these animals housed (e.g. in cages, paddocks, in your house)?

Declaration and authorisation

I declare that all information I have provided in this form is:

- a) I consent to the Commission collecting, using and disclosing my personal information, and any other information I provided to the Commission, including to any third party, where such disclosure is necessary to process an application or notification. - b) In processing my application for registration, the Commission may require additional information from me that is, in the Commission’s opinion, necessary to determine whether to register or refuse to register me as a greyhound racing industry participant. If after 21 days of being requested to provide any additional information I fail to provide the information, the Commission may refuse to register me as a greyhound racing industry participant;
- c) If the Commission later determines that any information I have provided is, incorrect or deliberately false, disciplinary action may be taken against me, which could include suspension or disqualification of my registration or a warning off;
- d) I will immediately advise the Commission if there is any change to the information I have provided in any application or notification;
- e) While I am a greyhound racing industry participant, I will comply at all times with the provisions of the Greyhound Racing Act 2017, Greyhound Racing Regulation 2019, Greyhound Racing Rules, Code of Practice and the Commission’s policies.
