

GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Charge(s): Charge 1 - R156(x)

Mr. Bonner did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence, by associating with a disqualified

person for the purpose of greyhound racing.

Charge 2 - R156(f)(ii)

Mr. Bonner did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes misconduct, by allowing a disqualified and unregistered person to be involved in the training of a

greyhound.

Charge 3 - R156(f)(ii)

Mr. Bonner did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes misconduct, by allowing a disqualified and unregistered person to be involved in the training of a

greyhound.

Charge 4 - R156(f)(ii)

Mr. Bonner did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes misconduct, by allowing a disqualified and unregistered person to be involved in the ownership of a

greyhound.

Plea: No plea entered

Disciplinary action taken: Charge 1 - To issue a fine of \$4000 and an 18-month

suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Bonner not breaching this, or any like

rule, in the 12-month period.

Charge 2 - To issue a Disqualification of 4 months.

Charge 3 – To issue a Disqualification of 10 months.

Charge 4 - To issue a Disqualification of 2 months.

With the Disqualification periods to be served concurrently, commencing 21 May 2024 and expiring 21 March 2025

DECISION:

- 1. Mr Bonner was, at all relevant times, a registered Owner Trainer and Breeder with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- Between 24 June 2022 until or around 13 February 2023 Mr Bonner associated with a disqualified person for the purposes of greyhound racing.
- 3. Between 13 September 2022 and 25 January 2023 and again between 8 August 2022 and 26 September 2022 Mr Bonner allowed a disqualified person to be involved in the ownership or trainership or care and control of two greyhounds registered as being trained by Mr Bonner. Additionally, between 24 June and 1 August 2022, Mr. Bonner trained a greyhound which was owned or co-owned by a disqualified person.
- 4. On Tuesday 2 April 2024 Mr Bonner was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("Notice"). The Notice issued four charges against him for breaches of the following Greyhound Racing Rules:

R156(x), Greyhound Racing Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

. . .

(x) being a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified or warned off person for the purposes of greyhound racing;

Rule 156(f)(ii), Greyhound Racing Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

..

- (f) has, in relation to a greyhound or greyhound racing, done something, or omitted to do something, which, in the opinion of a Controlling Body or the Stewards:
- (ii) constitutes misconduct or is negligent or improper
- 5. The Notice invited Mr Bonner to attend a hearing on Friday 3 May 2024, and to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charges.
- 6. Mr. Bonner failed to appear at the hearing held via Microsoft Teams on Friday 3 May 2024 and the decision makers found him guilty of all charges in his absence.
- 7. On Wednesday 8 May 2024 the following proposed penalties were issued to Mr. Bonner in writing;

- **Charge 1 –** To issue a fine of \$5000 and a 24-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Bonner not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period.
- **Charge 2 –** To issue a Disqualification of 6 months.
- **Charge 3 –** To issue a Disqualification of 12 months.
- **Charge 4 –** To issue a Disqualification of 3 months.
- 8. On Monday 13 May 2024 Mr Bonner provided written submissions in relation to the proposed penalties.
- 9. Following consideration of Mr Bonner's submissions, the decision-makers found the charges proven and determined to impose the following disciplinary action upon him:
 - **Charge 1 –** To issue a fine of \$4000 and an 18-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Bonner not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period.
 - **Charge 2 –** To issue a Disqualification of 4 months.
 - **Charge 3 –** To issue a Disqualification of 10 months.
 - **Charge 4 –** To issue a Disqualification of 2 months.

With the Disqualification periods to be served concurrently, commencing 21 May 2024 and expiring 21 March 2025

- 10. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
 - Mr. Bonner's failure to attend the hearing, however it was acknowledged he provided a subsequent explanation as to why he did not attend.
 - Mr. Bonner's registration history within the industry with no like prior offences;
 - Principles of specific and general deterrence and what message is sent to the industry in respect to such conduct.
 - Precedent penalties
