Clause 10(1)(f) of the Greyhound Racing Regulation 2019 provides authority for the Commission to ask you for information in relation to your greyhound.

Please be aware that when a greyhound is rehomed to a person outside of the greyhound industry, GWIC will register the greyhound on the Companion Animals register in accordance with the Companion Animals Act 1998.
