

Lifetime Owner – FAQs

<p>I have received a letter / email / SMS about having a lifetime owner registration. What do I need to do?</p>	<p>The information you received is in relation to lifetime owner registrations no longer being available for participants. We just need you to tell us if you wish to remain within the NSW greyhound industry or not. If you are still interested in remaining in the industry, you will need to complete our online form at https://gwic.smartygrants.com.au/lifetimeowner</p>
<p>Why are lifetime owner registrations ending?</p>	<p>The <i>Greyhound Racing Act 2017</i> does not allow participants to have lifetime registrations. We are contacting participants to determine if they are still interested in remaining in the industry so we can begin amending these to have an expiry date.</p>
<p>What will happen if do wish to remain in the NSW greyhound industry</p>	<p>We will record your interest to remain in the industry, if you are an owner or syndicate member and ensure we have your current contact details. Your registration will be updated with an expiry date of 30 June 2021. Next year, you will be required to renew your registration for either 1 or 3 years. There is no fee for this renewal.</p>
<p>What will happen if I don't wish to remain the NSW greyhound industry?</p>	<p>You will need to complete our online form at https://gwic.smartygrants.com.au/lifetimeowner We will record that you no longer have an interest in remaining within the industry and no further action is required from you.</p>
<p>What will happen if I do not respond by 11 December 2020?</p>	<p>Your registration will expire and you will need to reapply for a registration if you would like to participate in the NSW greyhound racing industry.</p>
<p>What is the difference between an owner and a syndicate member?</p>	<p>An owner is a person who owns a greyhound/s and a syndicate member is a person who is a member of a syndicate that owns a greyhound/s.</p>
<p>If I own greyhounds and not interested in remaining within the NSW greyhound industry, what do I need to do?</p>	<p>If you no longer wish to remain in the industry and have greyhounds in your ownership, you must either transfer ownership to a current registered participant or retire them in line with the Rehoming Policy.</p>
