## HOW TO.... Renew your registration

NSW greyhound industry participants have the option to renew for one or three years, with a 30% discount offered with three year registration renewals. Participants must renew all registrations they wish to keep, at the same time and for the same period of time.

Participants can renew:

## Hot Weather & Racing



38°C - racing abandoned.

32°C - dogs can be withdrawn from races without penalty. Extra ice & water at tracks.

26°C - race track kennels must not exceed 26°C.

22°C - vehicles at the track containing greyhounds must not exceed 22°C.

Under the Rules and the GRA, animals that may reasonably be used as a lure (such as small dogs, cats, guinea pigs, chickens and other birds) cannot be kept on the same property as greyhounds. However, you may apply for an Animal Exemption Order that allows you to keep them.

Applications to register or renew your registration include questions about animals that you keep on your property so applying for an exemption is part of the registration process. If your circumstances change before you renew, you can complete a separate application for exemption.
