EUTHANASIA OF GREYHOUND - VET CERTIFICATION



A greyhound owner or custodian who presents a greyhound to a veterinary practitioner for euthanasia a due to injury, illness, or following its assessment as unsuitable for rehoming, declared a dangerous / menacing dog or has attacked / bitten a person as permitted under the Rehoming Policy must have the euthanasia certified by the veterinary practitioner as provided for in this form. This form must be lodged within 2 days from the date that a greyhound is euthanased.

This form is issued under clause 10 of the Greyhound Racing Regulation 2019 which requires a greyhound racing industry participant to notify the Commission of specified information relating to greyhounds. The Rehoming Policy can be found by visiting www.gwic.nsw.gov.au/rehomingpolicy
