Charge(s): (1) Mr Marmara presented the greyhound 'Greek Bombshell'

("**Greyhound**") for the purposes of competing in race 11 at the Gunnedah meeting on 24 March 2021 in circumstances where

the Greyhound was not free of any prohibited substance

Prohibited Substance(s): Lignocaine and 3-hydroxylignocaine

Disciplinary action taken: 6-week suspension

REPORT:

Following receipt of a certificate of analysis from Racing Analytical Services Limited, the Commission conducted an investigation into the results of a post-race urine sample taken from the greyhound, 'Greek Bombshell' ("**Greyhound**") at the Gunnedah meeting on 24 March 2021.

Further analysis of the sample was conducted by the Australian Racing Forensic Laboratory, confirming the presence of lignocaine and 3-hydroxylignocaine.

Mr Marmara admitted the charge at the earliest opportunity.

The disciplinary action was conducted in writing in accordance with the participant's election.

DECISION:

1. Mr Marmara is a registered greyhound trainer and the trainer of the Greyhound. The Greyhound competed in race 11 of the Gunnedah meeting on 24 March 2021 ("Event"). Following the Event, a urine sample was taken from the Greyhound.

- 2. The post-Event swab revealed the presence of lignocaine and 3-hydroxylignocaine. Lignocaine and 3-hydroxylignocaine are prohibited substances under Rule 1 of the Rules.
- 3. The Commission charged Mr Marmara with an offence under Rule 83(2)(a), which reads:
 - (2) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound-
 - (a) nominated to compete in an Event;

. . .

shall present the greyhound free of any prohibited substance.

- 4. Mr Marmara admitted the charge, provided written submissions and elected to have the disciplinary proceeding conducted in writing.
- 5. The Commission found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against Mr Marmara:

To suspend his registrations for a period of 6 weeks.

- 6. In taking this disciplinary action, the Commission considered all evidence, including:
 - The length of time Mr Marmara has held a trainer registration in the greyhound racing industry, being since 1984, approximately 37 years;
 - Mr Marmara has no relevant prior matters in his disciplinary history;
 - Mr Marmara's admission of the charge at the earliest opportunity;
 - NSW greyhound racing precedents; and
 - Mr Marmara's submissions in mitigation of penalty, including his good character, personal circumstances, his review of his animal husbandry practices and his remorse.

7	7.	In addition, the Greyhound was disqualified from race 11 at the Gunnedah meeting on
		24 March 2021 pursuant to Rule 83(4) of the Rules.
