

GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Charge(s):	Charge – 165(c)(a)(iv)
	Ms Atkins did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence by engaging in an activity which constitutes misconduct.
Plea:	Not Guilty

DECISION:

- 1. Ms. Atkins was, at all relevant times, a registered Trainer and Owner with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- In messages posted to the Greyhound Racing New South Wales Facebook page on Monday, 11th March 2024, Ms. Atkins engaged in unseemly conduct in relation to an official of a Controlling Body
- 3. On 30 April 2024 Ms Atkins was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("**Notice**"). The Notice issued a charge against Ms Atkins for breach of the following Greyhound Racing Rule:

Charge - Rule 165(c)(a)(iv), Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

Disciplinary action taken: To issue a fine of \$500

...

(a) engages in contemptuous, unseemly, improper, insulting or offensive conduct or behaviour in any manner or form towards, or in relation to:

(iv) a Club, or an officer, employee or member of a Club;

- 4. The Notice proposed a penalty of a \$2000 fine and invited Ms. Atkins to attend a hearing to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty.
- 5. On 16 May 2024 Ms Atkins attended a hearing held via telephone and;
 - Entered a plea of not guilty; and
 - Made verbal submissions.
- 6. After considering Ms. Atkins plea and verbal submissions, the decision-makers found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against her:

Charge – To issue a fine of \$500

- 7. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
 - Ms. Atkins Not Guilty plea
 - Ms. Atkins registration history with no prior offences for any like matter
 - Penalty precedents
